

Tecumseth South Central Public School Council Annual Report 2019/2020

Dear parents/guardians and school community,

The school year 2019/2020 was an unusual year.

After a successful back-to-school BBQ held on September 26, we started into the year with our first meeting on September 30, 2019. Full of enthusiasm we began planning the school year, fundraising events, support opportunities for students and staff and our involvement in school activities.

Throughout the fall, we were able to support the Terry Fox Run, continue the pizza and sub lunches and organize the first art "Card Project" fundraiser. School council supported the school boards' goal of going "paperless" and transitioned most fundraising activities to the "school cash online" platform. Members of school council also supported the implementation of Tecumseth South new logo and helped setting up online order options for spirit wear, an ongoing fundraiser.

School council meetings are open to the public and we encourage input from parents/guardians and other members of the school community; meeting dates are published in the newsletter, on the school website and school council Facebook page.

We like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of the many individuals who volunteer their time and efforts to contribute to the work of our school council. Even though our year was cut short, we accomplished many things and can look back to a prosperous 2019/2020.
