**Annual Report 2020/2021**



Dear Parents/Guardians and School Community,

The 2020/2021 school year was another challenging year. As students completed most of the year virtually, our School Council did not get to host any in-person meetings or events during the past school year. All our meetings were held virtually via zoom.

During the brief in-class period Council was able to successfully organize our annual wreath fundraiser. In December, we launched an account with “Fundscrip” in the effort to raise money through gift card purchases. Our fundraising efforts were communicated via the parent council Facebook page, the school newsletter and email distribution list.

Pizza Kits and Family Pizza Night were our biggest and most successful fundraisers this past year. Funds we raised during the past school year were used to purchase snowshoes for all students to enjoy during the winter months, “Class of 2021” hoodies for our grade 8 graduates as well as general school supplies (sport and outdoor equipment). Any remaining funds will transition into the new school year and go towards the improvement of our school’s outdoor learning facilities.

Council formed a committee which focusing on creating and building an outdoor learning facility for our students. The idea is to build an outdoor shelter/pavilion which would provide a sheltered outdoor leaning space. Secondly, we plan to have garden beds built that students can care for. Both these projects will be carried into the new school year, and we will keep you posted.

Our School Council used the ‘Parents Reaching Out’ Grant money provided through the Ministry to host a virtual “Family Art Night”, which received great feedback from families. There were 82 participants! In February, during Black History Month, we hosted the “Making Change” parent workshop, which was very educational and eye-opening.

School Council meetings are open to ALL PARENTS/GUARDIANS to attend, and we encourage input from parents/guardians and other members of the school community! Meeting dates are published in the newsletter, on the school website, and on the School Council Facebook page.

Council would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of the staff and administration at Tec. South and all their caring support for our students. We are wishing you all a joyful, relaxing, healthy and happy summer!

We are hopeful to host the annual “Meet the Teacher” BBQ at the beginning of the upcoming school year and can’t wait to meet and greet all of you in person once again!
